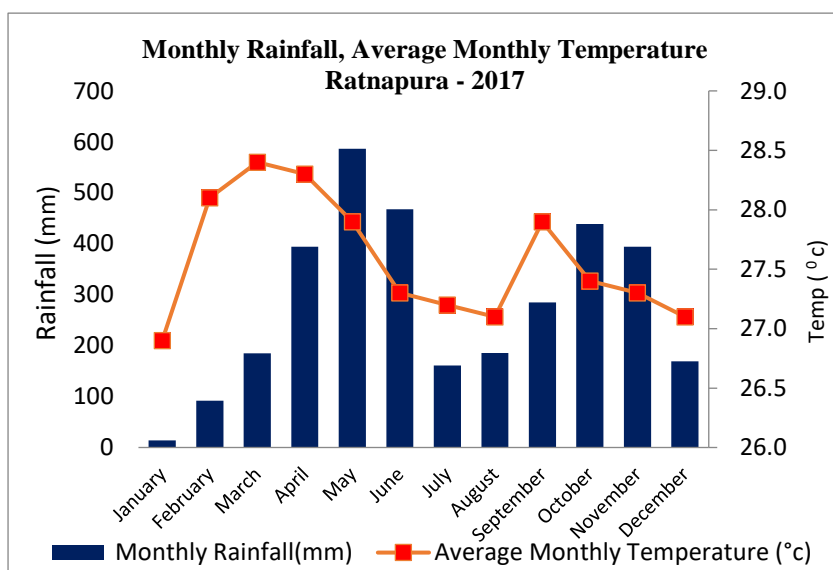

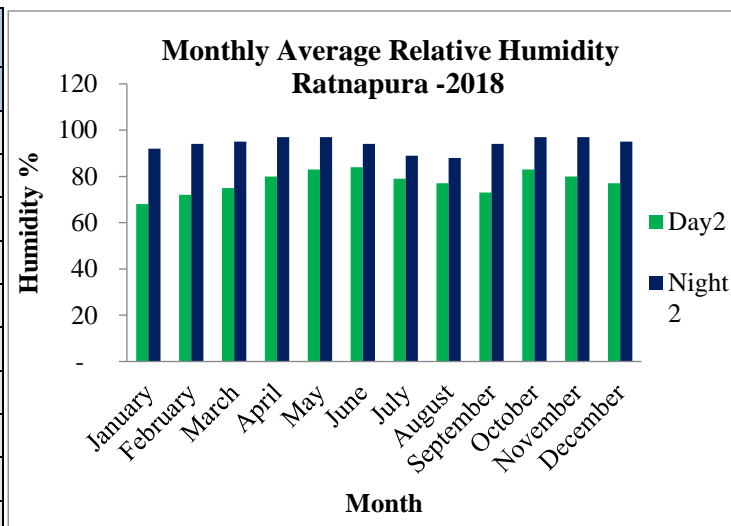

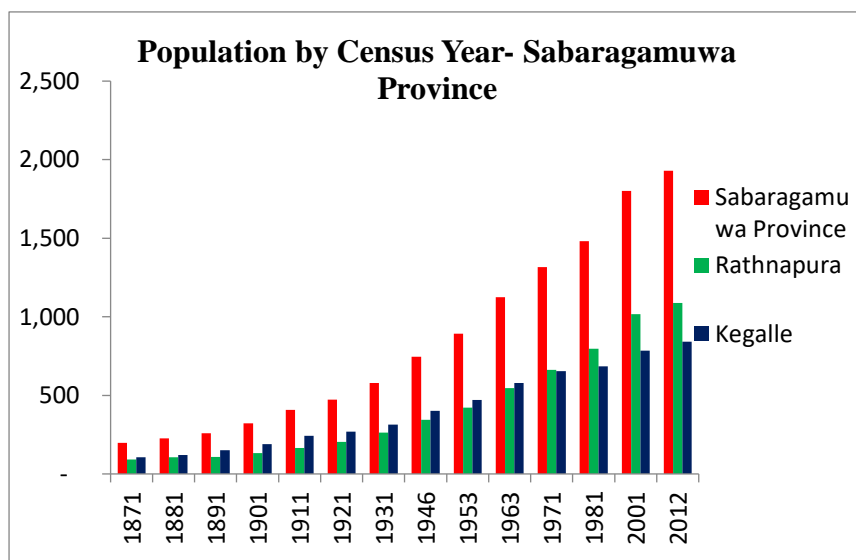

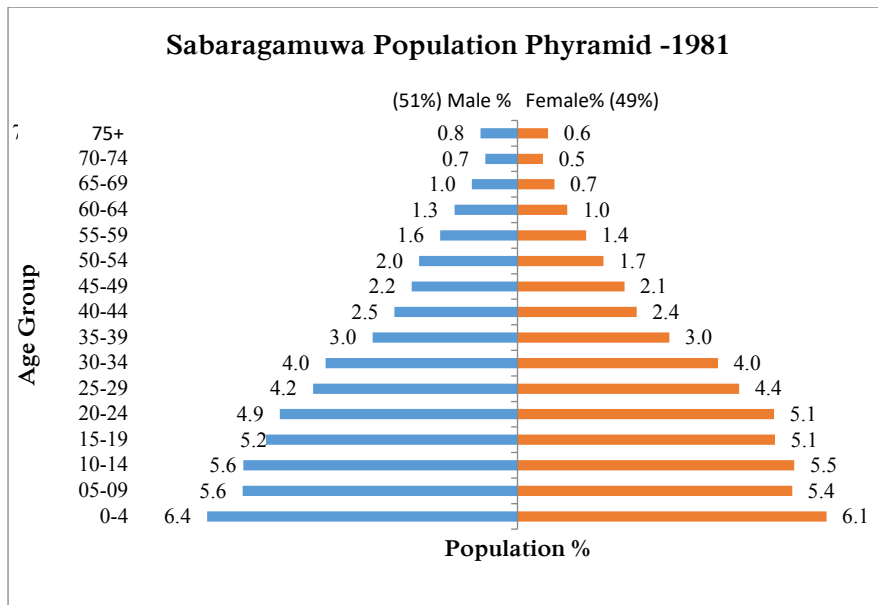

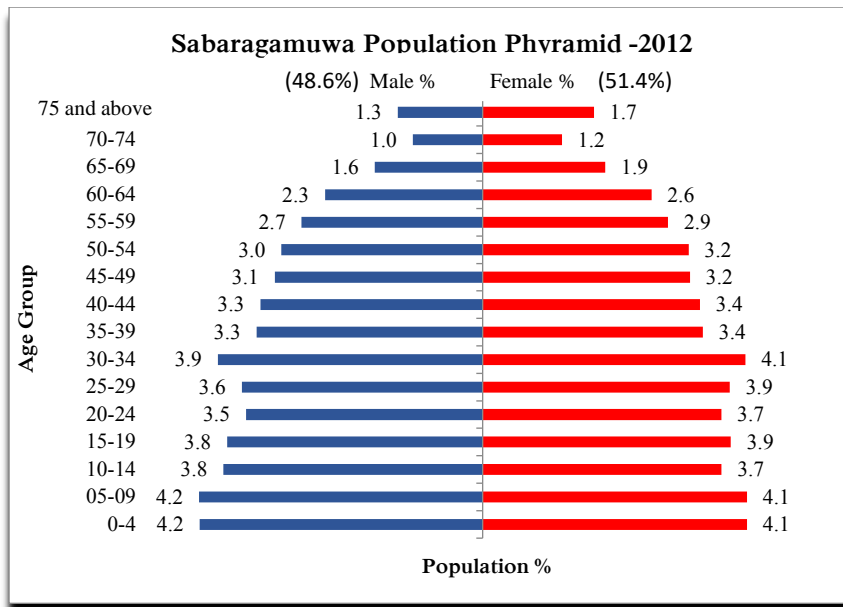

Sabaragamuwa Province- Population Pyramid- 1981



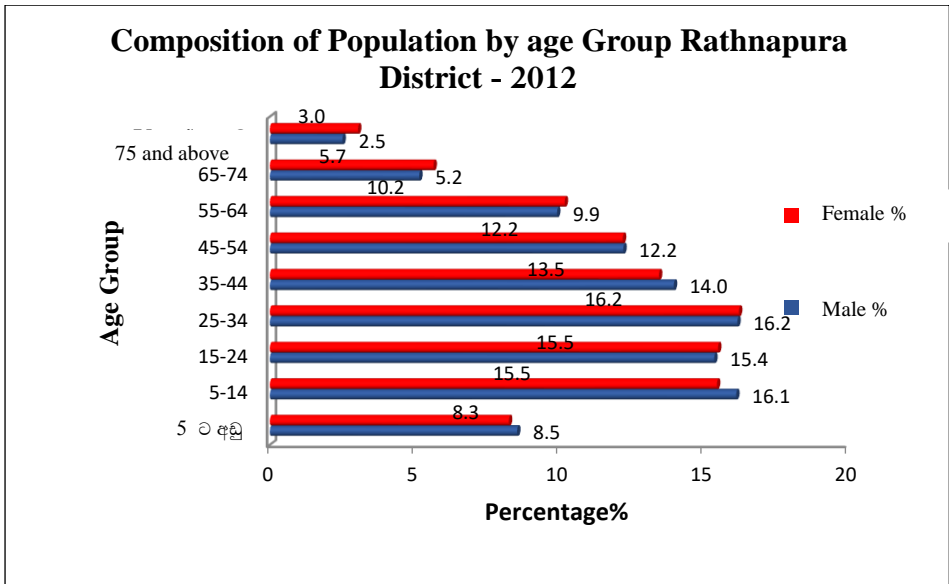

Sabaragamuwa Province- Population Pyramid- 2012



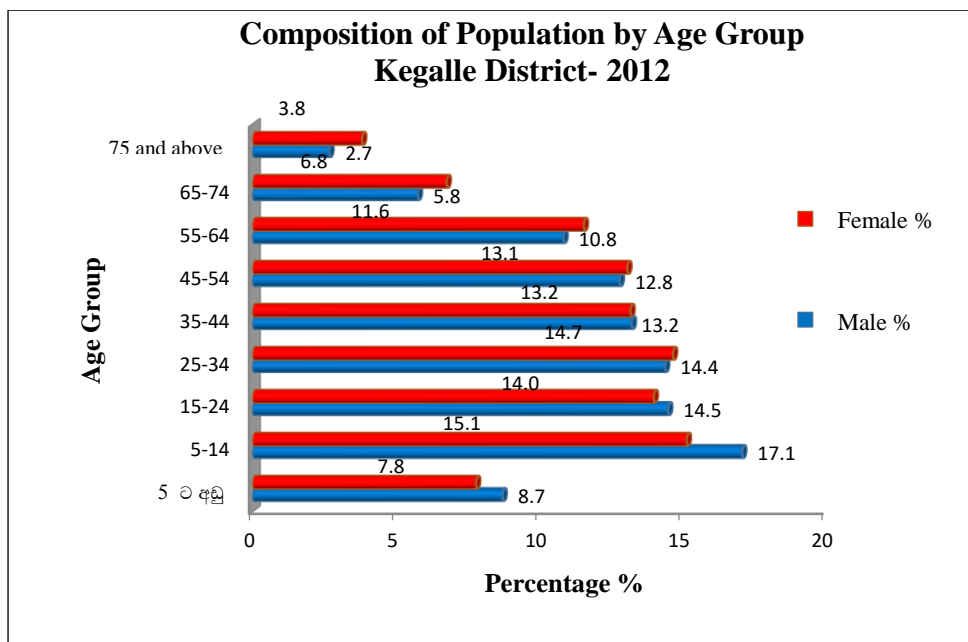

Composition of Population by Age Group Kegalle District- 2012

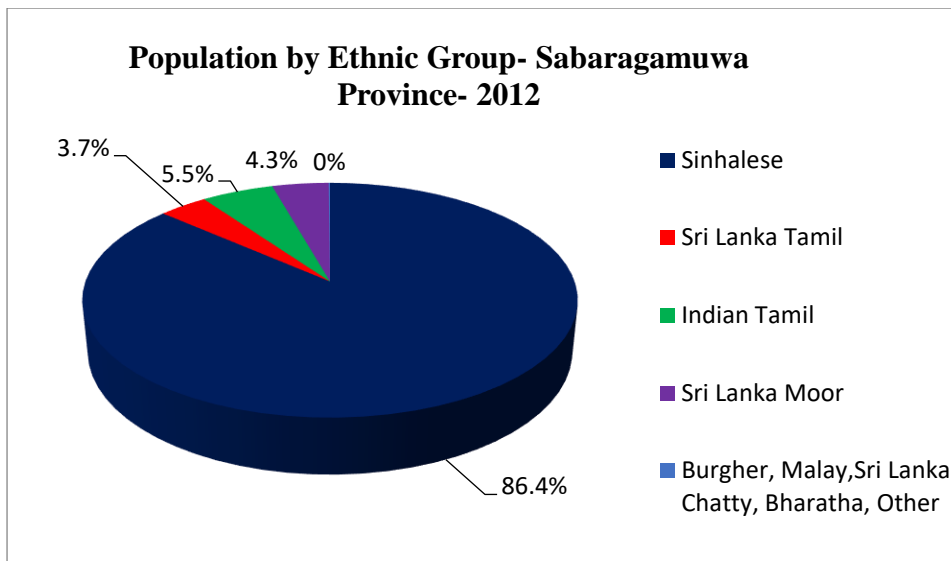

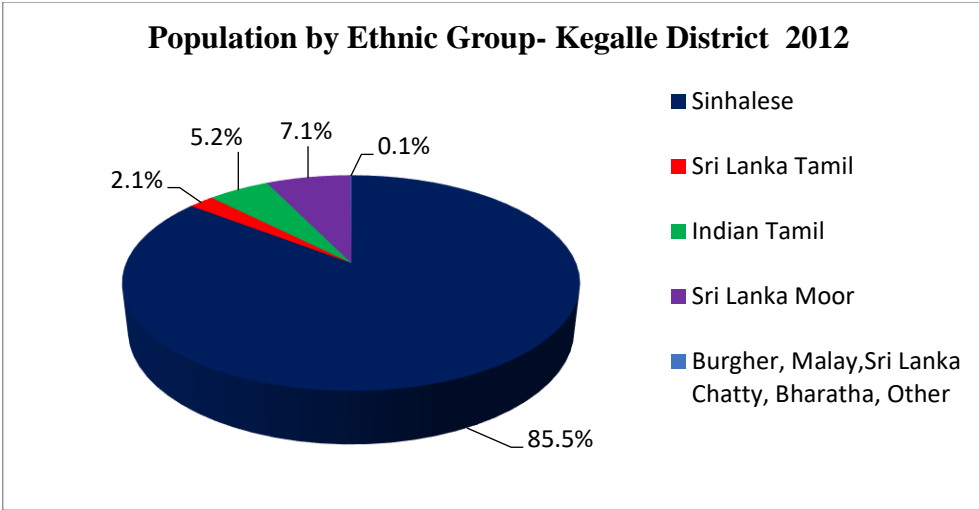

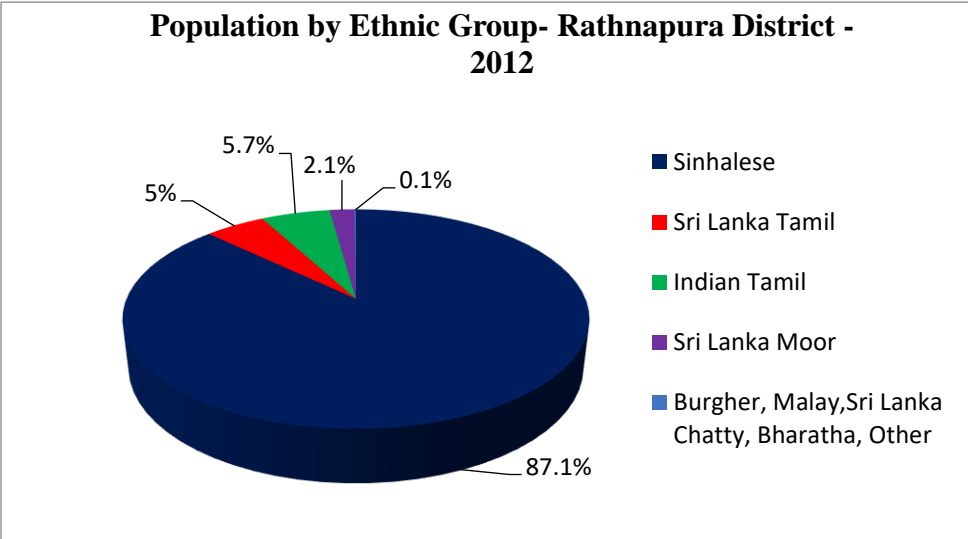

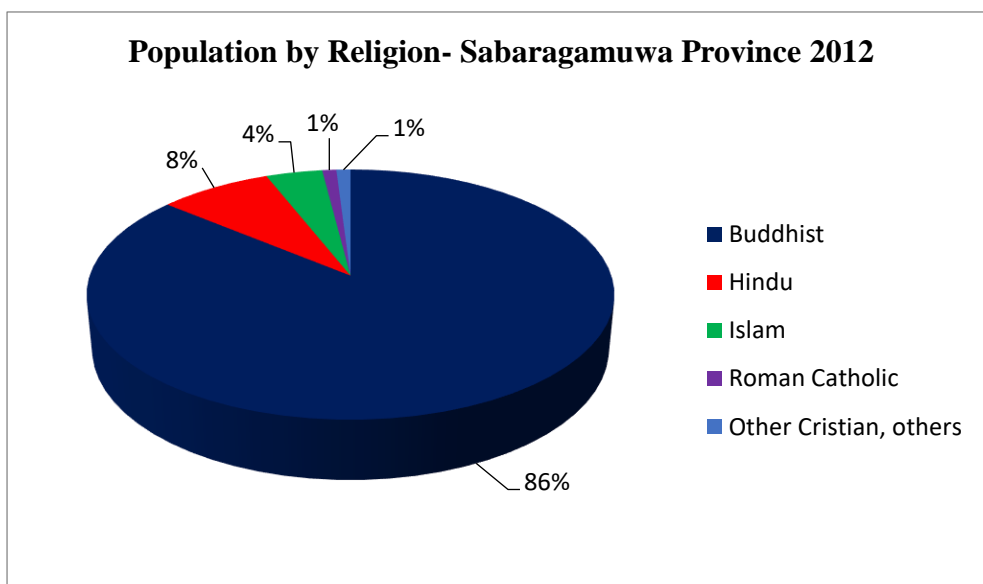

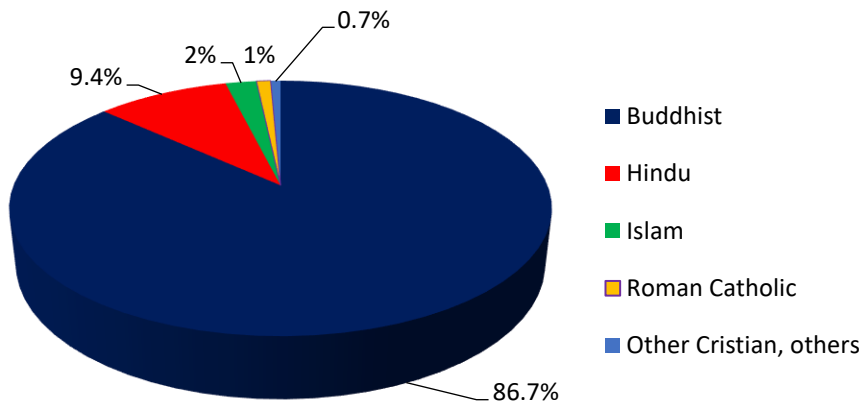

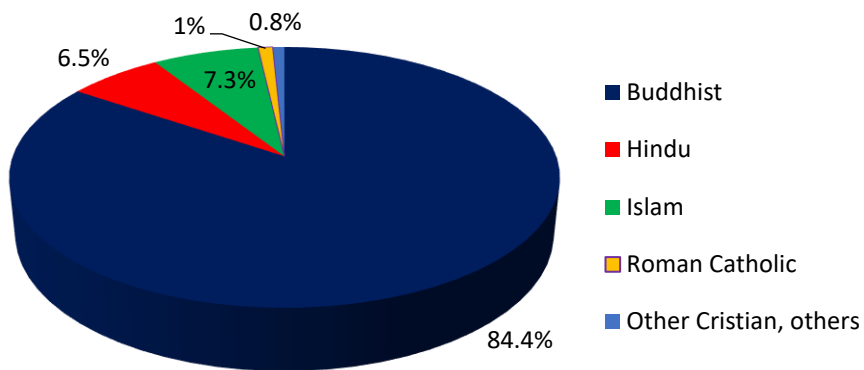

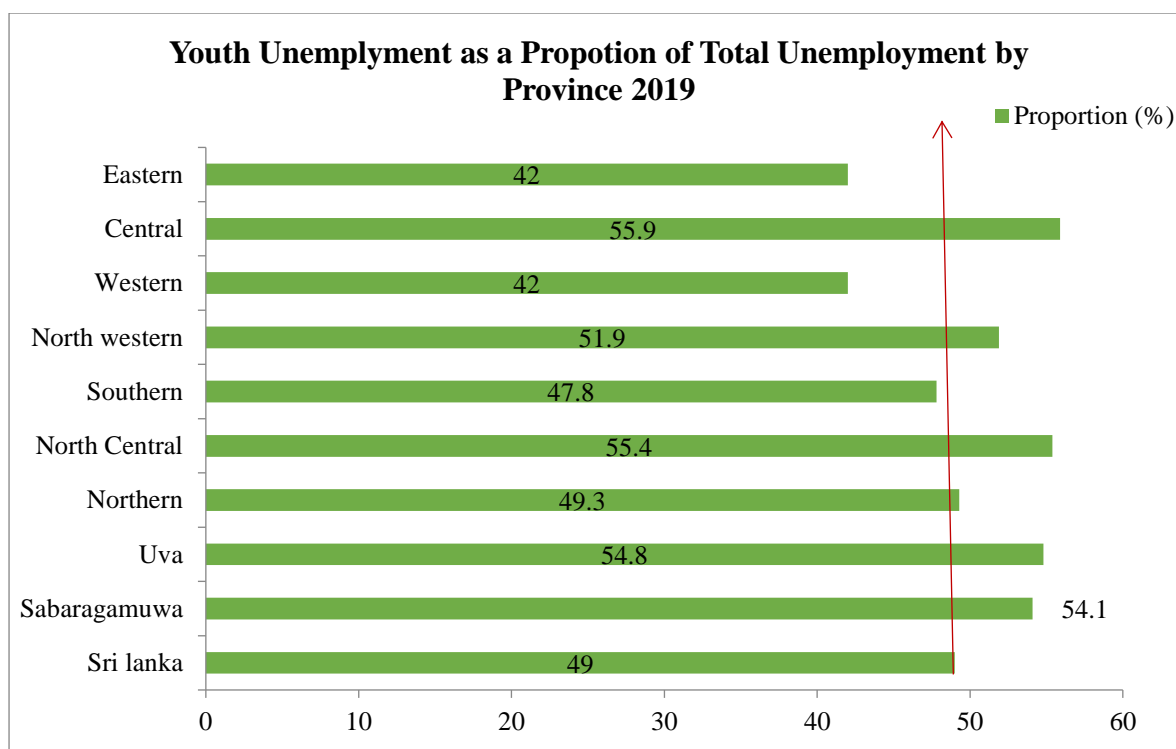

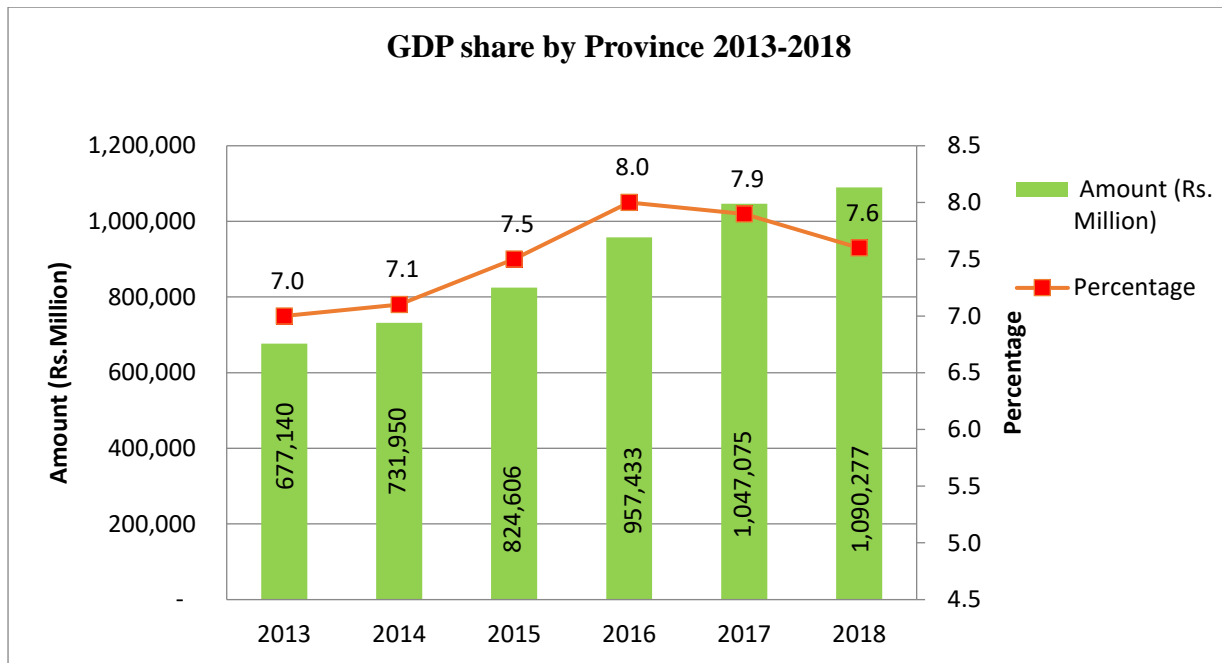

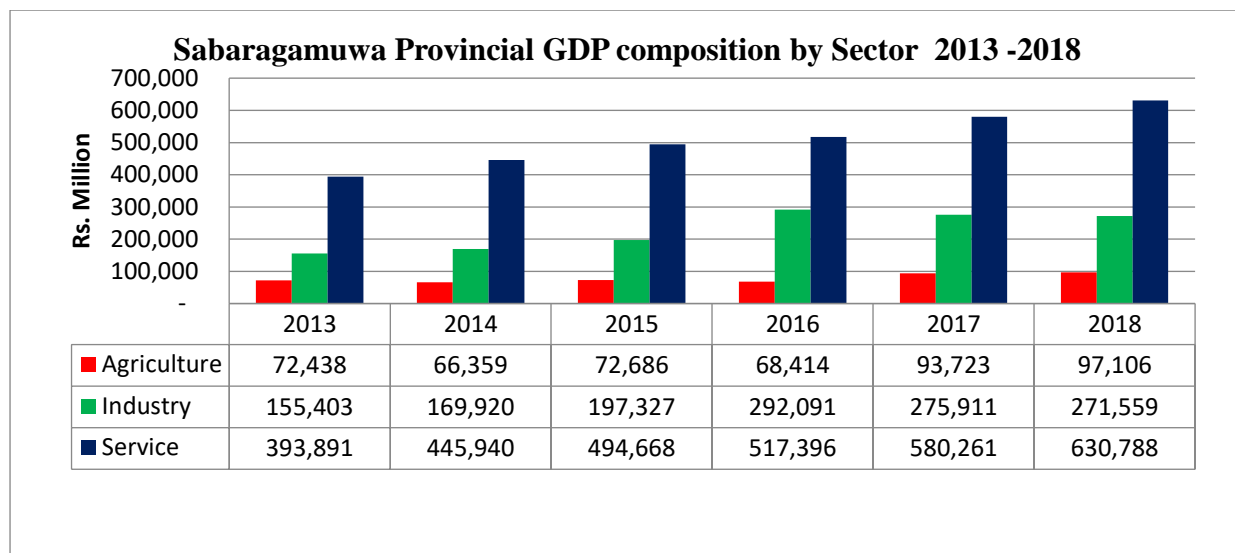

Sabaragamuwa Provincial GDP composition by Sector 2013 -2018

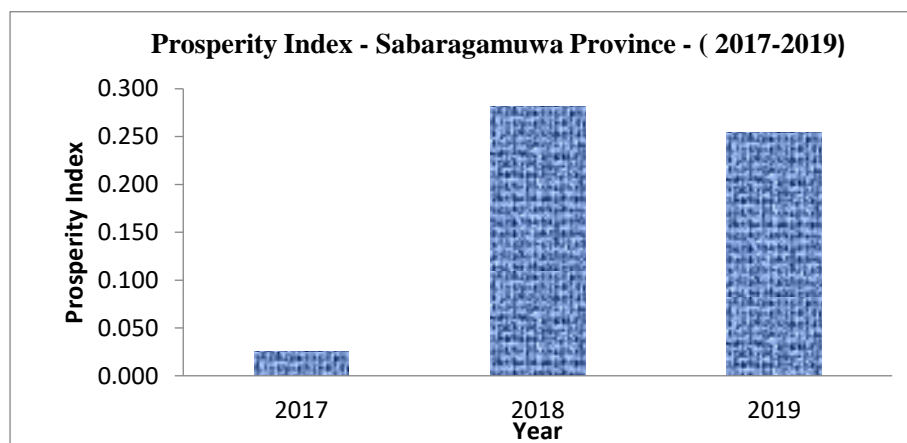

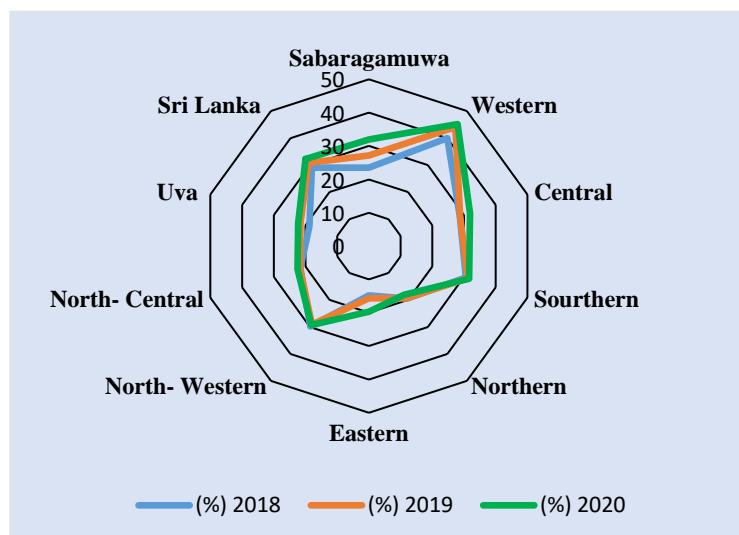

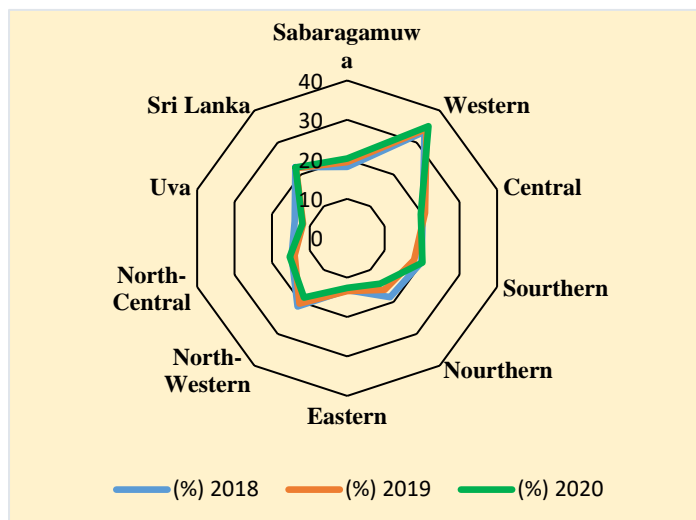
